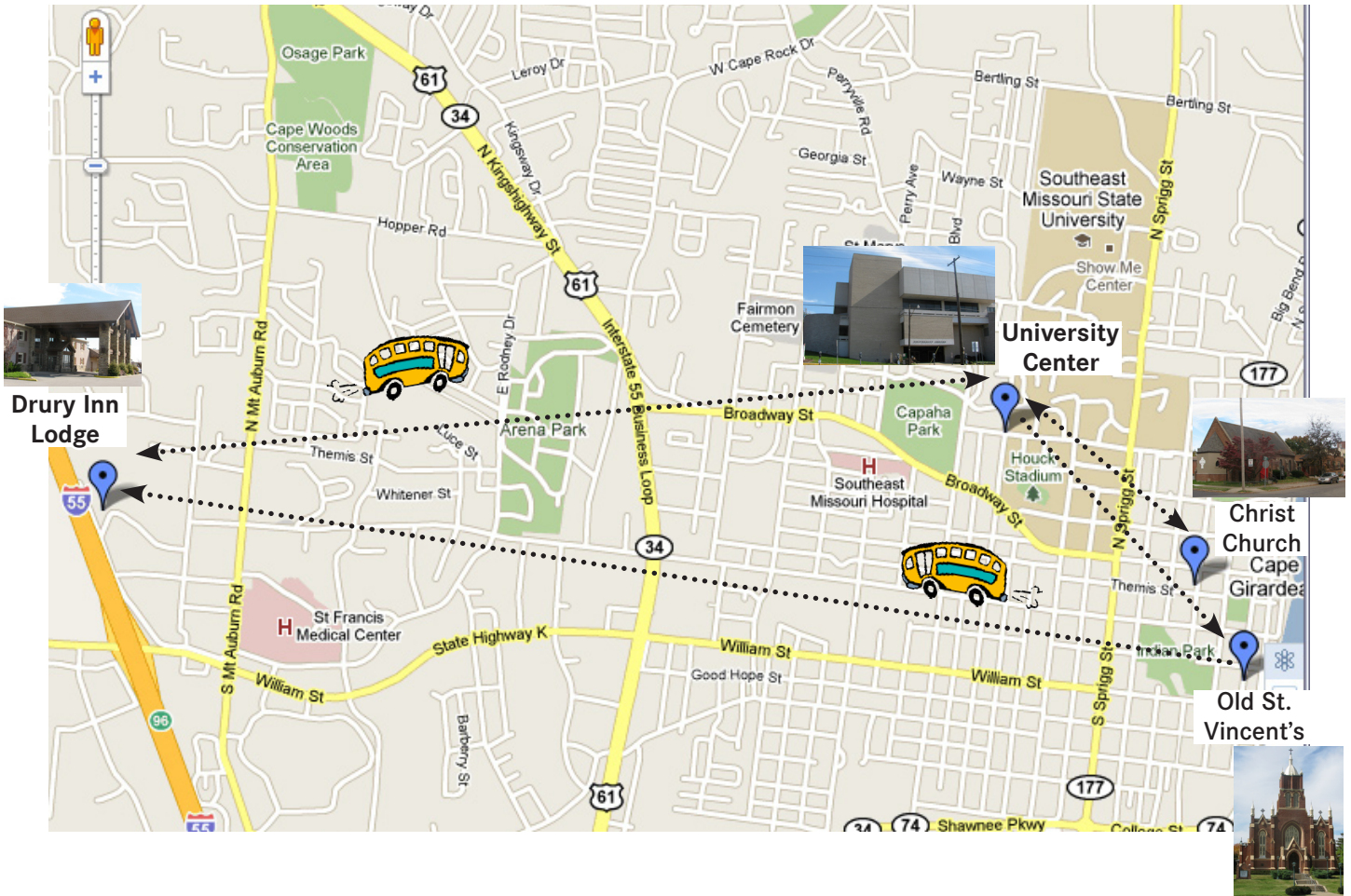


Convention Location and Logistics



Main Convention venue is University Center on the Southeast Missouri State University Campus. It is located on the corner of Normal and Henderson Streets.

Main Convention hotel is the Drury Inn Lodge, 104 S. Vantage Drive. Friday night's dinner will be hosted at the Lodge.

Old St. Vincent's Catholic Church, 150 S. Spanish Street, location for Friday Eucharist.

Christ Church, corner of N. Fountain and Themis Streets, is the location for Morning Prayer on Saturday, with breakfast provided by the people of St. Paul's-Sikeston.

Selected Convention Highlights

Keynote address from Dwight Zscheile. Zscheile is dedicated to helping church leaders imagine afresh what it means to be the body of Christ in today's changing environment. Ordained in the Episcopal Church, he was educated at Stanford, Oxford and Yale Universities and Luther Seminary, where he earned a Ph.D. in Congregational Mission and Leadership and serves on the faculty as assistant professor of congregational mission. Dwight served as executive pastor of St. David's Episcopal Church in Ashburn, Virginia, a rapidly-growing mission development congregation in America's second-most unchurched county. He currently assists part-time on the staff team at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in St. Paul. As a trainer and coach, his passions lie in leadership development and in helping churches reflect theologically and organizationally on their mission, structures and practices.

Four Vignettes. Some of the most commented highlights of conventions past have been the Diocesan Council Budget Vignettes.
